Introduction to Original Edition

The author examined carefully the eleven hundred or more pages of the Roman Lectionary, a volume containing scriptural passages for all the Masses in the new three-year cycle, for words which might cause the public reader difficulty in pronunciation: persons, places, and things.

Three possibilities for designating acceptable pronunciation were open to use: diacritical markings as found in most dictionaries, phonetics, and respelling.

For reasons explained later in these pages, respelling was selected as the easiest method of making pronunciations clear. It is hoped that the public reader will find the method helpful.

The Purpose of This Manual

The purpose of this manual is to help those who read the Scriptures aloud in the liturgy to do so efficiently and acceptably, particularly with regard to the difficult pronunciations of persons, places, and things found in readings assigned for the three-year cycle.

Before examining pronunciation in principle and practice, a review of the broader structure of scriptural proclamation in terms of general and basic principles is presented:

1. Public readers of Scripture are messengers of the Word of God.
2. Public readers of Scripture become better messengers by better understanding their message.
3. Public readers of Scripture become better messengers through rehearsal and performance.
4. Public readers of Scripture become better messengers by developing skills in visual and vocal technique.
 - a. Visual technique is revealed through bodily response. Bodily response in this case is not open, broad gesture but rather, *subtle* bodily expression and muscle tone.
 - b. Vocal technique is revealed through sufficient volume and projection, a conversational melody-pattern, variety in tone-color, the use of pace and pause, crisp enunciation, and finally acceptable pronunciation.

The Problem

Our alphabet has twenty-six letters to express as many as thirty-nine sounds. Our alphabet, therefore, is incomplete. Sometimes the same letter has to play several roles. For example, the letter "A" is used to express six different sounds: PLATE, CAROL, PAT, FATHER, ALL, and SOFA.

Strictly speaking, our alphabet does not have twenty-six separate letters. C is either S or K; Q is K; and X is KS. Therefore our alphabet has only twenty-three letters to express as many as thirty-nine sounds.

A second disadvantage in our limited alphabet is found in the pronunciation of some letter combinations. One example among many is the letter combination OUGH. These letters are pronounced differently in the words THOUGH, ROUGH, THROUGH, and COUGH.

To solve the problem of the inconsistency in pronouncing these and other letter combinations, three systems are possible: phonetics, diacritical markings, and respelling.

Phonetics, a system that uses a separate symbol for each vowel and consonant sound, was established by a group of international scholars in 1888. The same symbol always stands for the same sound, and the same sound is always represented by the same symbol whether the language be English, German, French, or any other. As a result, phonetics may be considered the most accurate way of representing vowel and consonant sounds for accurate pronunciation. The only difficulty is the fact that the system of phonetics is not generally taught in our schools, as are reading,

writing, and arithmetic, and as a result, few persons are able to read phonetics.

A second method of indicating speech sounds with visual symbols is the system of diacritical markings found in dictionaries. These markings are helpful, but unfortunately they differ in part from one dictionary to another. This lack of consistency can be confusing.

A third method is respelling, a system that this pronunciation guide follows. An attempt is made to spell the words in such a way that the acceptable pronunciation is immediately clear and obvious. For example, Deuteronomy is listed as Dyoo-ter-AH-nuh-mee.

To standardize the sounds of the words that will be visualized, the following *pronunciation key* is offered. Two basic assumptions underlie the use of the key in its application to the pronunciation of biblical terms:

1. No sounds foreign to American speech are introduced: for example, no rolled *r* or German or Scottish *ch* in *ich* or *loch*.
2. The pronunciations are based on General American. Those who speak with Eastern or Southern speech are encouraged to make their own adjustments wherever needed. In the pronunciation key that follows, notice that ***OO*** is a short vowel sound as in ***BOOK*** while the plain *OO* is a long vowel sound as in *MOON*. Notice, too, that the ***TH*** sound is the voiced ***TH*** as in ***THEE*** while the plain *TH* is the breath *TH* sound as in *THREE*. Finally, notice that the accented syllable is in capital letters as in *UHN-der-laind* (underlined).

Definition *

Pronunciation is the expression of sounds and accents of words in connected speech and in conformity with acceptable standards. From this definition of pronunciation four key elements arise: sounds, accents, connected speech, and acceptable standards.

- a. *Sounds*. The basic ingredients of spoken words are vowel and consonant sounds. Mispronunciations occur when vowel or consonant sounds are added, omitted, or substituted.

Words can be mispronounced when sounds are added or changed:

- b. *Accents.* Accents, as used here, do not refer to foreign accent but to the stress placed on a syllable of a word. Some words admit of differently accented syllables. Some words do not. A word can be mispronounced, therefore, by misplacing the accent.

- c. *Connected speech.* Connected speech refers to the pronunciation of words, not as single words, but as used in combination with other words. For example, the word BECAUSE is usually pronounced bee-KAWZ as an individual word, but in connected speech, unless the speaker wishes to emphasize BECAUSE, he may acceptably pronounce it bee-KUHZ. The purpose of speech is communication, and not to call undue attention to itself. Readers who pronounce every syllable of every word in connected speech the way they pronounce words singly, fail to follow Shakespeare's wise advice:

"Speak the speech, I pray you, as I pronounced it to you, trippingly on the tongue, but if you mouth it as many of your players do, I had as lief the town crier spoke my lines."

Connected speech permits no pauses in the sentence "Pat takes science." Pausing after "Pat" or "takes" would be affected and

overdone.

Examples of other pronunciation variations in connected speech involve the simple words A (UH) and THE (**THUH**).

Don't say AY MAN. Say UH MAN. Use AY only for emphasis. For example, "I didn't ask all of you to help. I asked for AY (one) helper."

Don't say **THEE** MAN. Say **THUH** MAN or better **TH** MAN. Say **THEE** for emphasis. For example, "He is **THEE** man of the hour." Or say **THEE** before a vowel sound. For example, **THEE** APPLE or **THEE** F.H.A. Even though *F* in F.H.A. is called a consonant, it begins with a vowel sound.

d. *Acceptable standards.* An acceptable standard is a model agreed upon by experts for imitation. There is no one pronunciation standard that is acceptable for all words in the English language. Variations are easily discernible in the speech of cultured British, Canadian, Australian, and American persons. In the speech of cultured Americans we find three general classifications: Eastern, Southern, and General American, and even in these classifications we recognize acceptable variations.

While it may be emotionally difficult for some persons to be tolerant of pronunciations of different areas, it must be admitted that language is the result of usage and not of preconceived rules. This is not to say that because thousands of persons say *toity-toid* for *thirty-third* or *dis* for *this* or *hep* for *help*, that these pronunciations are correct. Each locality has its unacceptable provincialisms. What we are looking for is a more general acceptability and uniformity. Since this uniformity is found more frequently among the better educated users of language, we look to them for our model of imitation. The principle of pronunciation which we derive from the foregoing reasoning is this: *Pronounce words the way the majority of better-educated persons in your general area pronounce them.*

To determine what pronunciations are used by the better educated persons in your area, listen to radio and television announcers on reputable stations as well as public speakers, teachers, and others

well versed in language. Choose those pronunciations for your own that sound most general and least different.

Finally, with regard to the pronunciation of biblical names, places, and things, listen to rabbis, pastors, and priests. They have had a broad religious background and specific training in Scripture.

The pronunciations used in this guide are traditionally and generally accepted by those who proclaim the Scriptures as public readers in the Church.
